FUTURE - GOING TO

(budoucnost vyjádřená vazbou going to)

Vazbu **going to** používáme, když je něco předem domluvené, když se něco chystáme udělat, nebo když máme něco v úmyslu.

Tvar **going to** používáme, pokud hovoříme o svých plánech do budoucnosti, o tom, co hodláme udělat. Budoucí čas s **going to** tvoříme pomocí tvaru slovesa:

to be + going to + infinitivu významového slovesa
